

tower hill reserve

According to most international visitors who visit Tower Hill, it is regarded as one of Australia's best kept secrets. Bordering Koroit on the south, Tower Hill was formed from a major eruption some 32,000 years ago and about forty others that followed. It is the traditional land of the Koroitch Gundidj people. Tower Hill was declared Victoria's First National Park in 1892 and is now part of the Kanawinka Geopark - Australia's first National Geopark.



Home to koalas, kangaroos, emus, many bird species and more, a number of walks including nature based cultural tours, picnic areas including free electric BBQs and public facilities make it a great experiential place to visit. Make sure you stop in at the Natural History Centre, managed by the Worn Gundidj Aboriginal Cooperative. See authentic aboriginal works and artifacts, a range of bush foods for sale and the story of Tower Hill. The centre is open daily from 9.00 a.m. to 4.30 p.m. More than a story – it is an experience. Tarerer Festival - November


A celebration of Indigenous Culture featuring - Music, Dance, Film, Trade, Food, Art and Community.
